Comprehension Scaffolds for Guided Reading

Based on Jan Richardson’s The Next Step in Guided Reading A useful way to discriminate among comprehension strategies is to classify them as requiring literal, interpretive, or evaluative thinking (Stead, 2006) Literal comprehension requires students to recall information that is explicitly stated in the text
